### 9-11 months

- Show early signs of separation anxiety • Cry more often when separated • Clingy with familiar adults • Become attached to specific toys/items
  - Understand "no"
  - Copy sounds and gestures of others

# **Atypical Social-Emotional Development**

### 6 months



• Extreme irritability or unresponsive to caregivers

12 months



- Does not seek comfort when upset
- Hard to console
- Stiffens

#### 18 months



- Shows few emotions
- no fear of strangers
- Does not seem to enjoy making caregiver laugh

### 24 months



- Kicks, bites, screams for no reason
- Does not show affection, likes or dislikes

#### 36 months



- May show no signs of empathy
- Does not greet familiar people
- Continued aggression
